## **Precautions**

The disc opening must be kept clean. Any dust must be wiped off. Dusty discs must be cleaned with clean, soft cloth before they are placed into the unit; otherwise, dust will be introduced by the disc. Dust will eventually affect the mechanism, causing the disc to eject slowly or not at all. For these kinds of problems professional is required to dismantle the unit and clear the dust.

## **GENERAL PRECAUTIONS**

- 1. Be sure to keep the disc slot clean. If you see dirt or dust on it, wipe it off with a clean, lint-free cloth.
- 2. Do not insert dirty or dusty discs into the disc slot. Dirt and dust introduced to the player mechanism in this manner may cause irreparable damage to the player.
- 3. Don't play this unit at maximum volume level for extended periods of time. It will shorten the life of the unit.
- 4. This player is a precision device. Do not open the case or attempt to make any repairs yourself.



- Blue-Power Antenna Control Wire
- Grey/ Grey black- right front speaker +/-
- White/White black-left front speaker +/-
- Purple/Purple black-right rear speaker +/-
- Green/Green black-left rear speaker +/-
- Orange rear view camera power control line
- Pink brake wire

# **Other Playing Modes**

## **AUX** input operation

To hear the audio from an external device connected to the front panel AUX IN jack, press the MODE switch on the front panel or remote control until AUX MODE is displayed.

Please note: The unit has a front panel AUX INPUT for Audio and a rear panel AUX IN for Video.

#### **REAR VIEW CAMERA INPUT**

If your car is equipped with a rear view camera, connect it to the Camera Video input on the rear panel. When you have connected it properly, which includes a connection to the vehicle's backup lights, when you back up the car the screen will automatically switch to display the view from the rear view camera. If you need to adjust the view from this camera, press the BAND button.

#### **GPS VIDEO INPUT**

This unit includes an input for an outboard GPS unit. To view the GPS display, press and hold the BAND button for three seconds, and make sure the GPS unit is turned on.

## **Basic Functions**

#### 1. Power on/off

Briefly press the PWR button on the panel or POWER button on the remote control to turn unit on. When unit is on, briefly press the POWER button on the panel or the remote control to turn power off.

## 2. Selecting an audio/video source

Press MODE button on the panel or SOURCE on the remote control to cycle through the available input sources: Radio→DVD(USB,SC card)→AUX *Note:* 

(1) If no disc, USB device or SD card is inserted, you cannot select DVD mode.





Input the number of the song you want to program using the number keys on the remote control.

To program the first song, input your desired song (for example, the sixth song) and press number button 6 on the remote control. Program the second song, press ▼ button move the cursor to 2 [\_\_] . 



#### 13.PLAY/PAUSE button

During disc playback mode, pressing INTRO will play the first 15 seconds of a track and then skip to the next track and play 15 seconds, and so on. This enables you to easily find a specific track. When you hear a track you would like to listen to, press INTRO again and it will stop the scanning process and continue with that track.














17.ZOOM button

In DVD mode, this button is used to zoom into the screen image. Please note that some discs do not support the ZOOM function.

18.AUDIO button

In DVD mode, press the AUDIO button to change the dialogue language for the program or movie. Please note that these languages are limited to those which have been encoded into the disc by the producers of the disc.

In VCD mode, use this button to select from a few different audio setups.

19.SUBTITLE button In DVD mode, press this button to switch the language of subtitles.

20.UP,DOWN,LEFT,RIGHT,ENTER button In DVD mode, use these four arrow buttons to navigate the various menus. Press ENTER to confirm choices.

21.PBC/MENU button In VCD mode, press this button to start PBC (Playback Control) mode. This mode creates a song directory for the disc. Use the number buttons to make selections.

22.ANGLE button

Some DVD discs offer the viewer the opportunity to see a scene from a different camera angle. If an alternate camera angle is available to view, an "angle mark" will appear on the screen. Press the ANGLE button when you see this and the camera angle will change. Please note: The Angle Mark function is only available on discs which have been so encoded by the producers of the disc.

23.SETUP button In Audio Mode,press this button to choose different set items.

24.SLOW button

In Audio Mode, press this button to play a track at reduced speed.

## CHANGING THE BATTERY

When the remote control must be held very close to the unit for it to work, or it has stopped communicating entirely, you should change the battery.

Press the release on the battery drawer with one hand, and with the other, withdraw the battery drawer.

Before you remove the battery, take careful note of the polarity.



Remove the old battery and place a new one in the drawer.

# **Operation of Radio Functions**

#### 1.BAND SELECTION

Press BAND button on the panel to change in the radio band as follows:

#### 2. MANUAL TURNING

Turn the SEEK +/- knob on the panel to change the radio frequency in single steps until the desired frequency is displayed.

SEEK TUNING In Radio mode, turn and quickly release the SEEK+/- knob or briefly press the SEEK +/- buttons on the remote to seek the next station on the radio band.

#### 3. APS

In radio mode, briefly press the APS button on the front panel (or the AMS/RPT button on the remote control) to browse among the preset stations. Press and hold these buttons to start the automatic station setup mode, in which the radio automatically scans the frequency bands and stores the strongest stations as FM presets.

Please note that the automatic station setup mode will erase your current presets and replace them with new ones.

#### 4.STEREO/MONO TRACK SELECTION

In Radio mode, press the ST/PROG button (on the remote control) the 00 symbol on the screen to toggle between STEREO and MONO FM reception modes. Most FM stations are broadcast in stereo. But if you find the reception of an FM stereo broadcast to be weak, often switching to MONO mode will improve overall sound quality.

#### **5.STORING RADIO IRESETS**

In Radio mode, to store a Radio preset, tune manually to a desired station and then press and hold the preset button (on the remote control) or area (on the touchscreen) until you hear a beep.

#### 6.RDS Radio Channels

## (1) AF (Alternate frequency)


This button turns on the RDS system AF mode which ensures that you are receiving the selected station on the best frequency available.


## (2) TA (Traffic alerts)

This button turns on or off the reception of the TA (travel advisory) stations. It automatically searches for the closest station. When there is a traffic advisory broadcast, it will automatically switch to this station. When the broadcast is over, normal radio mode will resume.



During disc playback, press and hold this button for fast forward playback or fast reverse playback, according to the following speeds:



#### 2. PREVIOUS/NEXT SONG


In DVD mode, turn and hold the SEEK+/- knob or the SEEK +/- buttons on the remote control to skip to the next or last song and play it.

## 10. ANGLE MARK FEATURE

Some discs are produced with the "angle mark" feature which offers the viewer the opportunity to view a scene from an alternate angle. When there is an alternate angle available, the program displays an "angle mark" indicating that you can make this selection. Press the ANGLE button to cycle through the available angles.

Please note the following:

- 1. This feature must be controlled from the remote control.
- 2. The disc you are viewing must support the Angle Mark feature. There is usually a camera symbol on the cover of the disc advising you of this feature.
- 3. Viewing changes are not permitted during slow playback.

## 11. MULTIPLE LANGUAGE SOUNDTRACKS

Some discs offer more than one language for the dialogue of a movie or program. If a disc is recorded in this manner, you can press the AUDIO button repeatedly on the remote control to cycle between the various languages available.

Please note the following:

- This feature must be controlled from the remote control.
- 2. The disc you are viewing must support the Multi-Language feature. There is usually a symbol on the cover of the disc advising you of this feature.

#### 12. TITLE MENU

In DVD mode, press TITLE button to return to the DVD title menu. The display will show all the titles on the disc. You can select the chapter you wan using the cursor. Then press the play button to play the chapter.

Please note: This function can only be accessed via the remote control.

## 13. MENU SELECT

During playback, press the PBC button on the remote control, or the MENU button on the touchscreen to return to the menu. The display will show the chapter and section of the disc. Use the UP or DOWN arrow to make a track selection. Press the OPEN/ENTER button to begin playback.

#### 14. EJECT DISC

To eject a disc, first press the RELEASE button on the front panel. Then press the EJECT button on the base unit to eject the disc.

#### 15. PROGRAM PLAY

In DVD mode, you can set up a sequence of tracks for playback using the program function:



## **17. SET UP**
